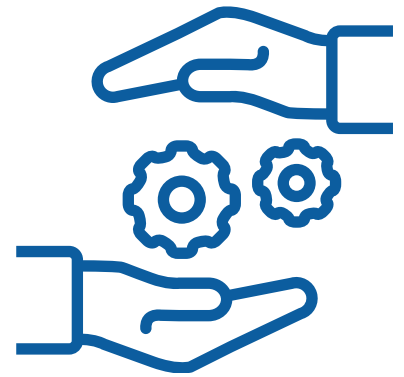


Our Mission
